Charter School Year-End Celebration

At the conclusion of each school year, the A.C.E. Foundation gathers educational partners and community stakeholders to sponsor “Annual Charter Schools’ End-of-Year Celebration.” Over 100 public charter schools across Florida, California, Nevada, Texas, and Washington DC participate in the event, which is complimentary to all charter school staff members. Each school recognizes an “Educator of the Year” with an award. Over 3500 guests are expected to attend this year.

From securing start-up grants for new schools to providing direct funds for materials and uniforms for needy families, the ACE foundation supports initiatives specific to the needs of each charter school in order to expand their capacity in meeting the needs of their communities.



Summer Camps and Afterschool Programs

This summer, the ACE Foundation partnered with Mater Academy of International Studies to create unique summer camp experience. Over the course of five weeks, 170 of the lowest performing students in grades first through fifth attended the summer camp. The focus was to provide additional support and remediation as well as reinforce foundational skills in the subject areas of math and reading. Students received instruction in both areas daily. Additionally, students participated in fun and creative activities which included: cooking days, water days, arts and crafts, movie day, and field trips. The program was a perfect balance of fun and academics, students were provided with a program that not only gave them the opportunity to grow academically but also gave them a safe place to enjoy their summer.

For the 2017 year, the A.C.E. Foundation aims to raise \$50,000 to create a summer program at our most impoverished schools for students who will benefit the most.
